● CRACKDOWN AGAINST WARIS PUNJAB DE CHIEF

Amritpal on the run, internet services down across Punjab

78 persons arrested, several detained: Police

Chandigarh, March 18

A TOTAL OF 78 persons have been arrested and several detained so far in connection with the crackdown launched against the chief of suspected pro-Khalistan outfit Waris Punjab De, Amritpal Singh and his aides, Punjab Police said on Saturday, adding that the Khalistan sympathiser is still on the run. "Punjab Police on Saturday

launched a massive state-wide Cordon And Search Operations (CASO) in the state against ele-

ments of Waris Punjab De (WPD) against whom several criminal cases stand registered," police said, adding that in the operation a total of 78 persons have been arrested so far, while, several others have been detained for questioning. Officials privy to the development said the preacher had almost been caught but he managed to give a slip to the approaching police team, which intercepted his cavalcade in Mehatpur village in Jalandhar district on Saturday. Some supporters of Waris Punjab De chief shared some videos on social media claiming that policemen were chasing them. A video also showed


Amritpal sitting in a vehicle and one of his aides could be heard saying policemen were after 'Bhai saab' (Amritpal). The Punjab Police had registered cases against Singh and his supporters earlier last week in Ajnala for alleged hate speech. Singh gained more prominence in February this year when a man complained at Ajnala Police Station alleging he had been kidnapped and beaten by the associates of the radical preacher. An FIR was registered against Amritpal Singh and six of his associates. Police later arrested one Lovepreet Singh Toofan, a close associate of Amritpal, in the matter.

Nashik can become defence equipment hub: Gadkari

NASHIK IN MAHARASHTRA can become a defence equipment manufacturing hub as it has companies like the Hindustan Aeronautics Limited or HAL, said Union minister of road transport and highways Nitin Gadkari here on Saturday. In his inaugural address of 'Know Your Army', a two-day arms and equipment exhibition of the Indian Army, Gadkari cited the example of the Multi-Model International Passenger and Cargo Hub Airport in Nagpur' (MIHAN) and said Nashik has a similar potential. "Rafale aircraft are being manufactured at MIHAN in Nagpur. As many as

450 engineers from engineering colleges in the area have got jobs there. The Falcon jet aircraft will also be manufactured there soon...As many as 1,200 parts of Airbus and Boeing are manufactured there," he said. Nashik also has a plant of HAL, the state-owned aerospace and defence company, and other defence manufacturing units and training facilities at Deolali, Gadkari said. "All these will give scope for defence manufacturing here. It will create new jobs in Nashik, help exports grow and these equipment will be used for the protection of our country," he said. India used to import modern weapons but the Make in India programme under PM Narendra Modi has changed the dynamics, according to him.

Unseasonal rains: IMD asks farmers to postpone harvesting

New Delhi, March 18

AS UNSEASONAL RAINS and hail are expected in the next few days due to western disturbances, India Meteorological Department (IMD) on Saturday advised farmers of Punjab, Haryana and Madhya Pradesh to postpone harvesting of wheat and other rabi crops. In case of matured crops, the IMD has advised farmers to harvest crops like mustard and chickpea in some states at the earliest and store them at safe places. Farmers have also been asked to withhold irrigation to wheat crop to avoid lodging. In the last 24 hours, IMD said light/moderate rainfall and thundershowers were observed over most parts of the country. Even hailstorm was

observed over Uttarakhand, Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Rayalaseema in Andhra Pradesh and North Interior Karnataka in the last 24 hours.

In its latest forecast, the IMD said isolated thunderstorm, lighting, squall and hailstorm is expected over Uttarakhand, Uttarakhand,

Rajasthan and Chhattisgarh on March 19; over West Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and East Rajasthan on March 20; and over Uttarakhand on March 21. The likely strong wind/hail may damage standing crops, injure people and cattle at open places, and partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds, it said. In this likely scenario, the IMD advised farmers to "postpone harvesting of crops in Punjab, Haryana and West Madhya Pradesh; if already harvested, store at safe places to avoid losses." Farmers have also been asked to withhold irrigation to wheat crop to avoid lodging. Rajasthan farmers have been advised to carry out harvesting of matured mustard and chickpea at the earliest store them in safe place.

India's daily Covid tally crosses 800 after 126 days

INDIA'S SINGLE-DAY TALLY of Covid-19 cases crossed 800 after 126 days on Saturday, while the number of active cases climbed to 5,389, as per Union health ministry data. With 843 fresh infections, the country's caseload increased to 4.46 crore (4,46,94,349). The death toll rose to 5,30,799 with four fatalities, the data updated at 8 am stated. While Jharkhand and Maharashtra reported one death each, two were reconciled by Kerala. At 5,839, the active cases now comprise 0.01% of the total infections. The national Covid-19 recovery rate was recorded at 98.80%, as per the health ministry website. — PTI

UBS eyeing swoop for Credit Suisse

The mood in Switzerland, long considered an icon for banking stability, was pensive as executives wrestled with the future of the country's biggest lenders. "Banks in permanent stress," read the front page headline of the *Neue Zuercher Zeitung* newspaper on Saturday. Credit Suisse ranks among the world's largest wealth managers and is considered one of 30 global systemically important banks whose failure would cause ripples throughout the entire financial system. In a sign of its vulnerability, at least four of Credit Suisse's major rivals, including Societe Generale and Deutsche Bank, have put restrictions on their trades involving the Swiss bank or its securities, five people with direct knowledge of the matter told Reuters. Goldman Sachs cut its recommendation on exposure to European bank debt, saying a lack of clarity on Credit Suisse's future would put pressure on the broader sector in the region. The sector's fundamentals were stronger and the global systemic linkages weaker than at the time of the global financial crisis, Goldman analyst Lotfi Karoui wrote in note to clients. This trend greatly limited the risk of a potential vicious circle of counterparty credit losses, Karoui noted. "However, a more forceful policy response is likely needed to bring some stability," Karoui said.

BlackRock not working on rival bid

The boards at Switzerland's top two banks expect to meet separately this weekend to weigh the idea of a combination, with talks orchestrated by the Swiss National Bank and regulator Finma, the *Financial Times* has reported. Bloomberg

Deutsche Bank eyes some assets

Discussions have touched on what parts of Credit Suisse would be attractive and what valuation they'd put on desirable assets should they come to market if it's acquired by UBS Group or broken up, the people said, asking not to be identified. The German bank's deliberations so far are internal and it hasn't made any concrete proposals to the Swiss lender yet, the people said. Bloomberg

PM bats for higher millets output, inclusion in PDS

Stressing that millets can be grown easily in adverse climatic conditions and without chemicals and fertilisers, Modi said India's millets mission will benefit 25 million small and marginal farmers. He said the government has launched a production linked incentive (PLI) scheme for the food processing sector and companies

should take advantage of the programme to increase production of millet-based products. Currently more than 500 startups are working on millets and several farmer producers organisations are engaged in millet production. Modi said the sale of millet food products has also seen a boost of roughly 30% The PM unveiled a customised postal stamp and a ₹75 currency coin for commemorating the International Year of Millets-2023 being celebrated by the UN General Assembly. A book on millet standards was released, while Hyderabad-based Indian Institute of Millets Research was declared as a global centre of excellence.

Low impact of small cities' incentive ban

Atop executive of another fund house pointed out that the regulator has kept this in abeyance, but it won't be done away with completely. "The regulator has observed distributors indulging in churning between schemes, hence the suspension. However, they are likely to come up with a revised plan to ensure more transparency and to curb malpractices," he said. Industry experts said Sebi's decision comes on the back of misuse of these incentives by some distributors. Dhirendra Kumar, founder and CEO of Value Research, said, "Many of them are indulging in switch transactions, which means moving money from one scheme to another. While it is registered as new money coming

into a new scheme, the redemption is not actually realised by anyone as the money is just being shifted." He highlighted that there won't be an impact on numbers given the temporary nature of the ban, adding that the regulator is working on a newer incentive model as it realises the importance of the growing B30 market. Reports suggest the regulator observed certain malpractices among distributors. These included splitting investments as the incentive was applicable for investments up to ₹2 lakh. Despite the discontinuation of the incentive, the role of distributors isn't seen being reduced. The CEO of one of the largest MF distributors in the country said: "The allegations of mis-selling isn't totally accurate. While churning was taking place to maximise commissions, these were happening only in some pockets."

He explained that the role of a distributor is primarily threefold. First, to help investors understand the product; second, to help them set goals and achieve them; and third, to provide guidance and feedback even after the investment has been locked in. In addition, he said with increased awareness among people about MFs even in smaller cities, the role of distributors has only increased, and there is a huge scope for them to expand their business not just in their perimeter, but also in nearby towns and regions where there is less competition and huge opportunity.

MG Motor looks to buck the trend, disrupt EV space with Comet launch

MG knows that the Comet won't be the first car in the car owner's family, as is the case with most of the EV owners in India. Because of the range anxiety associated with EVs, they are often the second car in the family, used for short intra-city commutes, while the bigger first car is the long-range, high-

Carlsberg India launched the Tuborg White, a European styled wheat-malt brew, and Australian wine brand Jacob's Creek has Unvined, a non-alcoholic wine with less than 0.5% alcohol. In the whiskey segment, Johnnie Walker launched Johnnie Walker Blonde, a light, sweeter version of whisky from Cameronbridge blended with fruitier whiskies from Cardhu. Shweta Jain, chief business development officer, luxury, reserve & craft - India & South Asia, Diageo, said, "Consumers have evolved in how people order and drink whisky, and the versatility and vibrancy of Johnnie Walker Blonde helps when it comes to a good drinking experience." Beer works best in hot climates, lighter than alcoholic drinks. Thus, urbanisation and change in societal perspective, along with the launch of new low- and no-alcohol variants, are propelling growth in the beer category. Avneet Singh, founder of the mid-segment beer (not too strong, not too mild) Medusa Beverages that was started in 2017, shared that they had a turnover of ₹70 crore in 2018 and expect ₹150 crore in the upcoming years, clearly showcasing that there is a huge demand for craft beer across the country. "People have started preferring beer to hard liquor because there's nothing like sipping a cold, fizzy beer on a hot day," he added.
